## Connections Data 8:07-8:30

Looking at results from surveys
Past 3 years of results
3 Categories - Student-to-Adult; Student-to-Student; Interests-to-Students

Student-to-Adult: 97.1% in agreement, "What do you notice?"

"Less students responded in 22 vs 21 but higher rates."

"I think this is so cool. When I was in school, I never had the chance to share my thoughts about teachers."

Ann explains the importance of this type of data for student success

Student-to-Student: 92.2% in agreement, "What do you notice?"

"This shows the effects of covid. Quick turn around after covid."

"This reflects the really intentional work on the social and emotional work from Bethke."

"Bethke was intentional in 2020 to connect emotionally even with covid."

Interests-to-Students: 76.4% in agreement, "What do you notice?"

Ann explains we do not have as many clubs as middle/high school

"My daughter enjoyed the art club. Balancin staff morale is hard with clubs because that is a lot of them. We could have this statistic go up with more clubs but staff morale would go down." "We don't have the means to encourage kids with every interest. This is pretty high considering

that."
